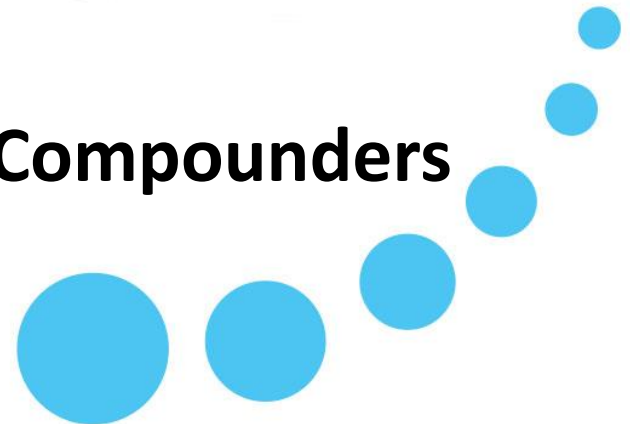

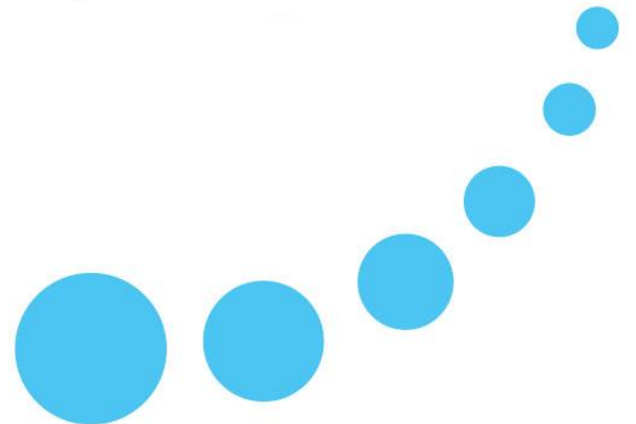

The Association of Masterbatchers and Compounders in Europe

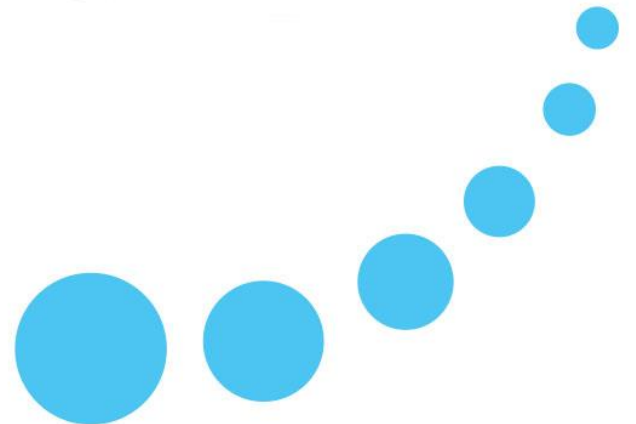
- An association of companies who have manufacturing operations in EU, EEA* and Turkey

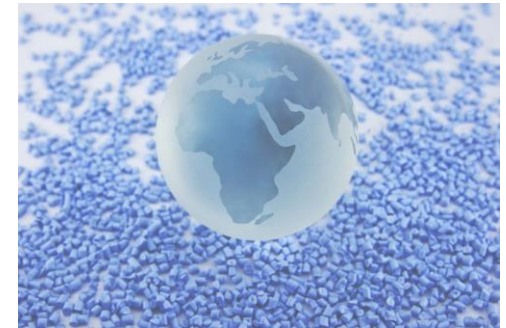


EuMBC – Our Vision



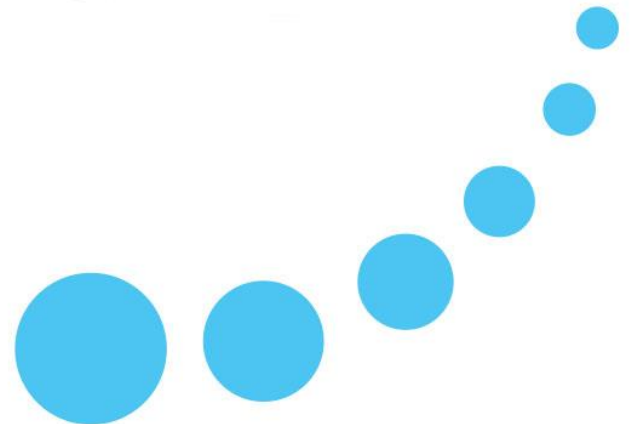
EuMBC is the voice of the Masterbatchers and Compounders in Europe

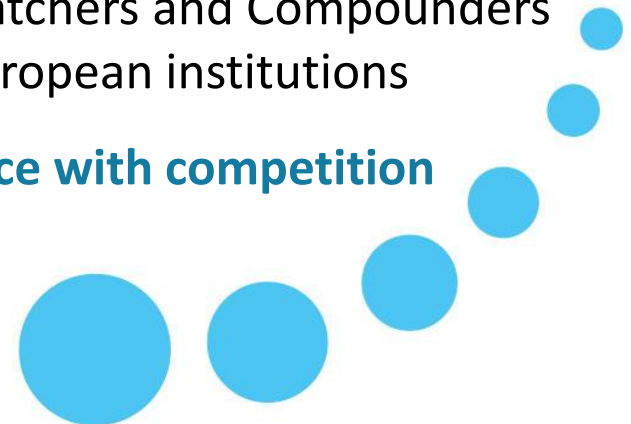




EuMBC – Our Mission

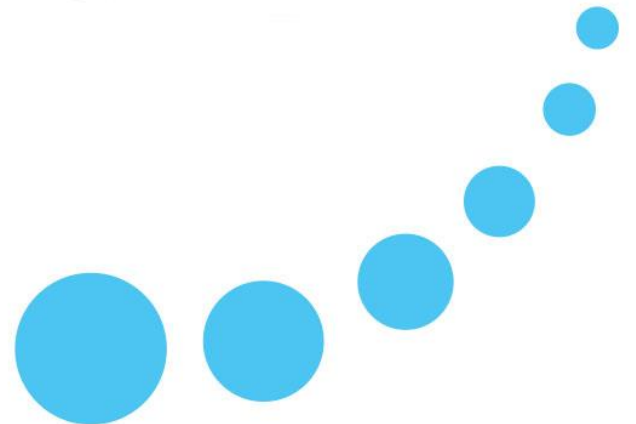


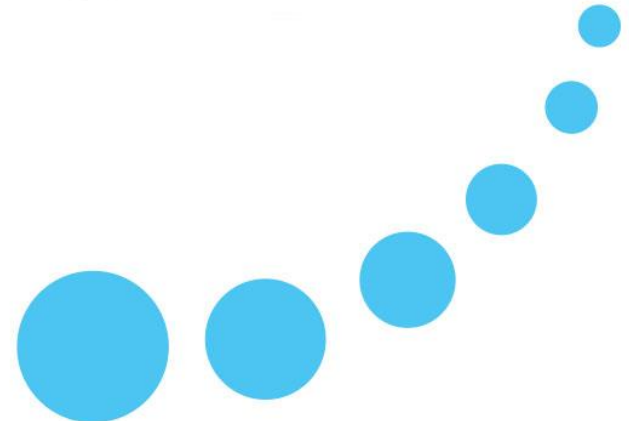
- **To represent the European Masterbatchers and Compounders**, and to stimulate their role across the entire plastics value chain

- **To act in a responsible manner and in accordance with competition laws**





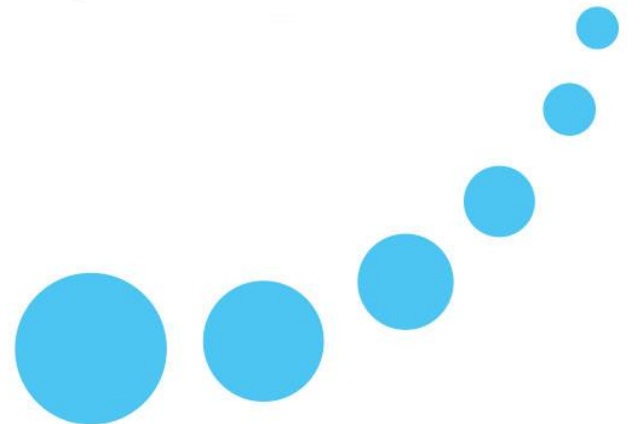

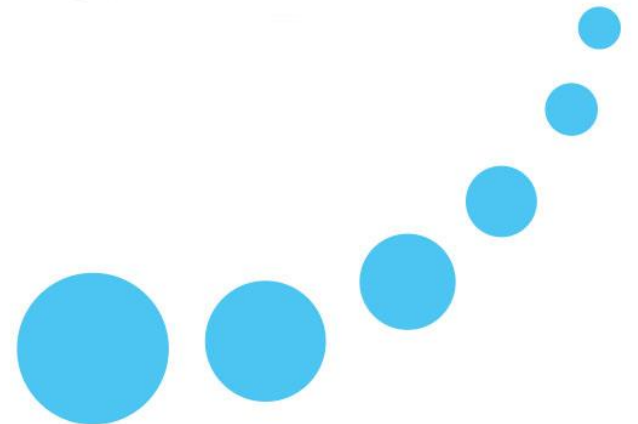

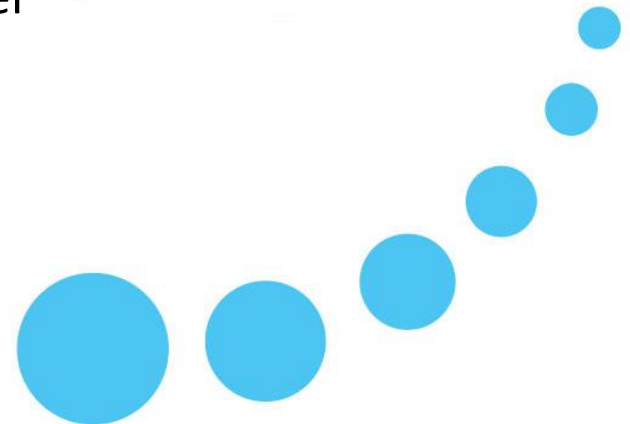
- **Support on REACH**

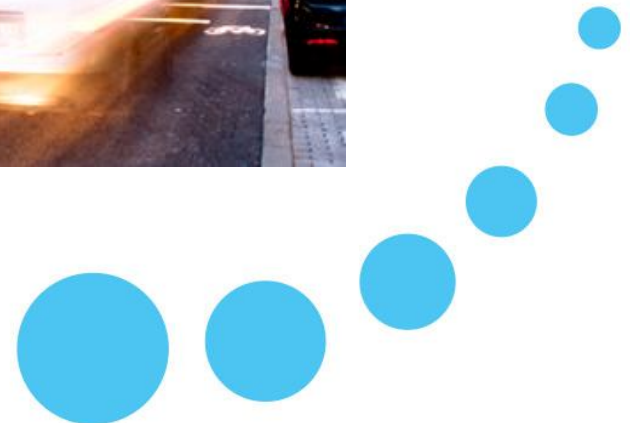
